DR FRANS HILGERS

FRANS HILGERS GRADUATED FROM THE MEDICAL FACULTY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF UTRECHT IN 1973. HE COMPLETED HIS OTOLARYNGOLOGY-RESIDENCY AT THE ACADEMIC WILHELMINA HOSPITAL OF THE UNIVERSITY OF AMSTERDAM UNDER PROFESSOR LEONARD JONGKEES IN 1978 AND HIS HEAD AND NECK FELLOWSHIP AT THE NETHERLANDS CANCER INSTITUTE IN AMSTERDAM UNDER PROFESSOR EMIEL VAN SLOOTEN IN 1977-78.

HIS PhD-THESIS, BASED ON CLINICAL AND LABORATORY RESEARCH ON IMMUNOLOGICAL ASPECTS OF HERPES VIRUSES IN HUMAN NEOPLASIA, WAS COMPLETED IN 1976 (WITH PROFESSOR F. DEKKING, UNIVERSITY OF AMSTERDAM).

SINCE 1978, HE HAS HAD AN APPOINTMENT AS FULL-TIME HEAD AND NECK SURGEON AT THE NETHERLANDS CANCER INSTITUTE AND FROM 1989 ON AS CHAIRMAN OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEAD AND NECK ONCOLOGY AND SURGERY. HE ALSO HOLDS A POSITION AS CONSULTANT FOR HEAD AND NECK SURGICAL ONCOLOGY AT THE ACADEMIC MEDICAL HOSPITAL OF THE UNIVERSITY OF AMSTERDAM.

IN 2003, FRANS WAS APPOINTED THE ROLE OF PROFESSOR AT THE UNIVERSITY OF AMSTERDAM (INSTITUTE OF PHONETIC SCIENCES) FOR 'ONCOLOGY-RELATED VOICE AND SPEECH DISORDERS, ESPECIALLY IN LARYNGECTOMIZED INDIVIDUALS'.

FRANS' CLINICAL RESEARCH FOCUSES ON POSTLARYNGECTOMY VOCAL, PULMONARY, AND OLFACTORY REHABILITATION. HE HAS WRITTEN 206 PAPERS, 129 OF WHICH CAN BE TRACED BACK THROUGH PUBMED, AND 62 OF WHICH DEAL WITH LARYNGECTOMY TOPICS. FURTHERMORE, HE CO-EDITED A TEXTBOOK (DISEASES OF THE HEAD AND NECK, NOSE AND THROAT; EDITORS ANDREW S JONES, DAVID PHILLIPS, AND FRANS JM HILGERS), WHICH HAS RECEIVED THE GEORGE DAVEY HOWELL'S MEMORIAL PRIZE 1999 FOR 'THE MOST DISTINGUISHED PUBLICATION IN OTOLARYNGOLOGY IN THE PRECEDING 5 YEARS' BY THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF MEDICINE IN LONDON, UK.

FRANS' EXPERIENCE IN POSTLARYNGECTOMY REHABILITATION HAS BEEN CONDENSED IN THE EDITED BOOK 'A PRACTICAL GUIDE TO POSTLARYNGECTOMY VOCAL AND PULMONARY REHABILITATION, INCLUDING THE PROVOK SYSTEM', OF WHICH THE FOURTH EDITION IS PUBLISHED IN 2003 IN CD-ROM FORMAT, AND IN A BOOK ON OLFACTORY REHABILITATION (IN DUTCH), OF WHICH AN ENGLISH VERSION ON CD IS PUBLISHED IN 2004.
